## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

NO ENTRIES WILL BE PROCESSED AND NO STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED WITHOUT RECEIPT OF PAYMENT. There will be a \$10.00 fee per horse for incomplete entries.

All NSF cheques will be charged a \$20.00 NSF plus a \$ 15.00 processing fee. AAHABC reserves the right to report any unpaid NSF cheques to AHA within 21 days of the horse show for which the NSF cheque was written.

All competitors (riders, drivers and handlers), owners, trainers and coaches must be current members of AHA as well as members Horse Council BC (or applicable PTSO) at the time of entry and at the time of showing. AHA non-members may purchase a single event membership for US\$40.00 (or C\$55.00). Competitors in lead line' walk/trot and all breed classes are exempt from AHA membership.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN 10 & UNDER WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST BE SHOWN!!! No competitor will be allowed to show without one of the above cards. No pending memberships!

Photocopies of all cards and horses registration papers must accompany entries. PROOF OF OWNERSHIP IS REQUIRED; both sides of the papers are needed if the owners name does not appear on the front. A copy of the Canadian registration papers is required to be kept by the show secretary, to be submitted to AHA.

Competitor numbers must be worn in the paddock or warm-up area prior to the class and in the show arena during competition. Failure to wear a competition number during the class MAY result in disqualification of the entry by the judge.

### CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:

#### Class Title Definitions:

Junior Horse - horse must be five years of age or younger

Maiden Horse - horse must not have won a first place in that division

Novice Horse - horse must not have won more than three first place ribbons in that division

Limit Horse - horse must not have won more than six first place ribbons in that division

#### Halter Division:

Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring and its movement is being evaluated and scored. The horse shall enter at a trot and proceed around the arena. Upon each horse reaching the designated position at the far end of the arena, they are to remain relaxed. Horses shall be asked to walk collectively counter-clockwise and/or clockwise past each judge. They shall walk in a relaxed manner on a loose lead with the handler at the side of his horse, whips down. The lead line must maintain a discernible drape and the handler must not place his hand on the chain or close enough to in any way restrict the natural head and neck motion. The handler may not unnecessarily impede the forward motion of the horse while at the walk. Following the cessation of the walk all horses shall relax within the ring and only the horse 'on deck' shall be prepared to show. Each horse shall be led to the judge at the walk and presented for judging. Horses shall walk away from the judge and then strike a trot before turning left and proceeding counter clockwise down the rail. They shall resume their relaxed position at the end of the arena. The scores for all categories will be completed, record-

collar or a different hue or modest piping or crystal decorations, are acceptable. Protective headgear, stocks, ties, gloves and riding boots may be of a matching colour to the coat.

**SADDLERY:** Bridles, basic grades – snaffle with either a drop, cavesson, flash or figure eight noseband permitted. On snaffle bridles, the type of reins is optional. All bridles must be correctly fitted (see EC Rule Book, Dressage Division for descriptions and illustrations of permissible snaffle bits.)

Saddle: A plain English saddle, black or brown in color only, with stirrups is compulsory in all levels.

Martingales or bearing, side or running reins of any kind are forbidden, as are bandages, boots or any kind of blinkers.

Whips (no longer than 120 cm) may be carried at this show in Dressage. Test readers may be used if provided by the exhibitor. Current dressage tests will be used.

Passports are not required by Arabian or Half Arabian horses at this show. Limited times are available for tests and they will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Dressage times will be available from Marla Patterson on May 1st, 2025 at (604) 313-4413 or on the AAHABC facebook page. No calls after 9 pm, please! Test times will be strictly enforced.

All horses will be required to undergo a tack and equipment check by the Steward after each test.

Please note the helmet rule for dressage. ALL riders, both adult and youth, showing in ANY levels must wear an ASTM/SEI or BSI approved helmet both in the dressage competition arena and the dressage warm up arena. See EC rule book/website.

## **Western Dressage Division**

Please refer to [www.westerndressageassociation.org](http://www.westerndressageassociation.org) for rules, tack and tests.

**DRESS:** required apparel: suitable western hat, long sleeved shirt with any type of collar: short sleeves may be worn at the discretion of the judge. Trousers, pants, a one-piece long sleeved equitation suit provided it includes a collar. Boots.

**SADDLERY:** Any western type headstall must be used. Bosals are permitted on a horse of any age at any level. Native and national bridles are permitted. Bitless bridles of Western style made of leather. Split reins on any bit. Romal reins are appropriate only with a curb bit and can only be ridden with one hand. Saddle: A standard stock saddle, national, working saddle, Aussie, native or western side saddle is to be used but silver equipment will not count over a good working outfit. A horn is not required but western style fenders are required. Tapaderos are permitted, except in Western Dressage Equitation. Whips: one whip no longer than 47.2 inches (120 cm) including lash, is permitted in all Classes/Tests.

All horses will be required to undergo a tack and equipment check by the Steward after each test.

## **Sport Horse Division**

**IN HAND:** Bridles are optional on two year olds, mandatory on horses three years old and over. A bridle shall be a dressage or hunter type with snaffle bit with or without cheeks, keepers allowed, reins and headstall with throatlatch. Noseband is optional. A split or single chain may be used with/or instead of reins. Handler may carry a whip up to maximum length of six feet. Conservative attire recommended for the handler. Braiding is optional. Boots or bandages of any kind are forbidden during the class.

**UNDER SADDLE:** Informal dressage or hunter attire required. Rider may carry a whip/crop, maximum length four feet. Horses shown under saddle are required to compete in a hunter or dressage type bridle with a snaffle, with or without cheeks, keepers allowed; or a pelham. Flash nosebands are acceptable, in dressage attire, when using a snaffle bridle with a snaffle bit. Martingales of any type prohibited, breastplates permitted. Type of English saddle shall be dressage or forward seat. Girth, either leather, web, string or suitable material. Braiding is optional. Boots or bandages of any kind are forbidden during the class. Hunt cap, derby, top hat or approved headgear is acceptable for sport horse under saddle and sport horse show hack.

## **English Pleasure**

It is imperative that the horses give the distinct appearance of being a pleasure to ride and display a pleasurable attitude. To this end, all gaits must be performed with willingness and obvious ease, cadence, balance and smoothness. To enter ring at a normal trot. To be shown at a Walk, Normal Trot and Canter. Open will be asked for the Strong Trot and Hand Gallop. Light contact must be maintained with all reins at all gaits. A judge may not request that these gaits be performed only on the snaffle or curb. No cross entry with country pleasure. No hunt attire. Junior Horses are to be judged on quality, performance, attitude, and manners. All other categories to be judged on manners, performance, attitude, quality, suitability of horse to rider, and conformation.

ed and may be announced at this time. A suitable headstall equipped with throatlatch is mandatory. Horses shown braided must be shown in hunter, show hack or dressage bridle, plain leather show halter or leather stable halter.

### **Performance Halter**

Horses must be 3 years of age and older, and must have been entered and shown in a performance class at the same show as the one in which the performance halter class is being held, or have completed an AHA or AERC sanctioned Endurance ride or a Competitive Trail Ride (CTR) recognized by AHA or sanctioned by an AHA recognized Competitive Trail Riding Organization in the past 90 days (exhibitors must present dated proof of completion to the show secretary). If classes are held at a recognized Endurance ride or CTR, all registered Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses entered in the ride are eligible to compete.

### **Ranch Horse Conformation**

The purpose of Arabian Ranch Horse Conformation is to preserve Arabian type and conformation best suited to the function of a natural ranch horse. Selection is based upon well-mannered individuals in the order of their resemblance to the breed ideal that possess the most positive combination of balance, structural correctness, and movement. Individuals should possess appropriate breed and sex characteristics with adequate muscling. The ideal Arabian ranch horse should have a natural ranch horse appearance from head to tail.

To be eligible to compete in the ranch horse conformation class the horse must be entered, shown and judged in at least one riding class in the Ranch division at that show. Horses must be at least 3 years of age. Horses in each division may be shown together as one class or divided into Purebred, Half-Arabian, Stallions, Mares, Geldings, Open, Amateur, Youth, or in any combination deemed appropriate by show management. All stallions shall be examined to confirm that they have two visible testicles. All stallions and mares shall be examined for over-shot and under-shot mouth. If examination reveals that a horse is a cryptorchid or has an over-/under-shot mouth, the judge shall not use such horse in the final placings of the class. Horses are to be shown in a good working halter: rope, braided, nylon or plain leather. Any horse shown in the ranch horse conformation class may not be shown with a lip cord/chain, however a lead shank with an attached chain may be used under the chin. No whips, nor any other attention getting devices (i.e. treats, candy) are permitted.

### **Liberty:**

Freestyle liberty is not to be judged solely on the individuals trot. Some horses may trot very little but will still exhibit type, animation and presence while giving a brilliant performance.

Judging criteria:

- 1) Arabian Type
- 2) Animation & charisma
- 3) Movement
- 4) Use of Arena
- 5) Crowd participation

Liberty Rules:

1. Open to Purebred and Partbred Arabians. Horses may show with white or black polo wraps and unweighted bell boots.
2. A 2 minute time limit will be allowed for each horse. Time and music will start when halter is removed. Time will expire at the signal of the time keeper. At that time handlers have two minutes to retrieve horse or it will be eliminated.
3. No more than two handlers per horse are allowed in the ring at one time
4. Handlers will lead horse to designated marker.
5. While at liberty, the horse may perform at any gait, horses may perform tricks within their 2 minute time at liberty to count towards their overall performance score. Handlers shall not touch the horse with the whip or ride the horse at any time from entrance into the show ring until after the expiration of the time limit. The use of a standard show halter whip is allowed. Each entry will furnish music for their performances. The music must be marked with the horses name and number. If no music is supplied the show reserves the right to select the music.
6. The scoring system is from 1-10 in five categories with a possible high score of 50.
7. These classes are not AHA or EC recognized or approved classes. The show committee shall handle all disputes and inquiries and their decision shall be final.

### **Dressage Division**

DRESS: At all test levels, riders may wear dark coloured jackets or vests in any single colour with subtle pin striping, checks or tweeds. Striped or multi-coloured coats or jackets are not permitted. Tasteful and discreet accents, such as a

## **Country Pleasure:**

OPEN: To enter ring at a normal trot. To be shown at a walk, normal trot, strong trot, canter and hand gallop. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance, quality and conformation. It is imperative that the horse give the distinct appearance of being a pleasure to ride. A quiet, responsive mouth is paramount.

AOTR, JOTR, JTR: do not strong trot or hand gallop. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance, quality, conformation and suitability of horse to rider.

SELECT: Has not received more than 100 AHA Achievement Points and has not leveled out of the National Select Amateur Level. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Select Rider in a respective section on December 1 of the previous year, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.

JUNIOR HORSE: to be judged on attitude, manners, quality and performance. It is mandatory in all classes that horses be asked to halt on the rail, stand quietly, back and walk off on a loose rein. No cross entry with English pleasure. No hunt attire. Day coat permitted.

## **Hunter Pleasure**

OPEN. LIMIT, NOVICE, AAOTR, JOTR, JTR, JUNIOR HORSE (5 YRS & UNDER): To enter the ring at a trot. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop both directions of the ring. To back readily and stand quietly. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability as a hunter, quality and conformation. Junior horses to be judged on quality, performance, suitability as a hunter, manners and conformation.

SELECT: Has not received more than 100 AHA Achievement Points and has not leveled out of the National Select Amateur Level. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Select Rider in a respective section on December 1 of the previous year, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.

## **Show Hack**

Horses to enter the ring at a walk or trot, at judge's discretion. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop both ways of the ring. Collected and extended gaits to be called for both directions; to stand quietly and back readily. Only twelve horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on manners, performance, quality and conformation. Manes and tails may be braided. No saddle suits or Kentucky jodphurs. Top hat and tails may be worn.

## **Ladies Sidesaddle**

ENGLISH: To enter the ring at a trot. To be shown at a walk, normal trot and canter. Horses should back readily, if required by the judge, and stand quietly. Riders may sit or post the trot. To be judged 85% on manners, performance, suitability, quality and conformation; 15% on appropriate sidesaddle attire. Manners and suitability of purpose shall be emphasized.

WESTERN: To enter the ring at the jog. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope. Horses to stand quietly and back readily. To be judged 85% on manners, performance, suitability, quality and conformation; 15% on appropriate sidesaddle attire. Manners and suitability of purpose shall be emphasized.

## **Native Costume**

OPEN, AOTR: To enter the ring at a canter. To be shown at a walk, canter and hand gallop. Saddles with stirrups required. Extreme or reckless speed to be penalized. Horses to stand quietly and back readily. To be judged 75% on performance and manners; 25% on appointments.

## **Western Pleasure**

OPEN. To be shown at a walk, jog-trot, lope and hand gallop. Extreme speed to be penalized. To be judged on manners, performance, substance, quality, conformation and attitude.

JUNIOR HORSE. To be shown at a walk, jog-trot and lope. Must never have been shown in any Western event in a bridle. To be judged on substance, quality, performance, manners and attitude.

SELECT: Has not received more than 100 AHA Achievement Points and has not leveled out of the National Select Amateur level. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Select Rider in a respective section as of December 1 of the previous

year, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.

JTR/JOTR/AOTR/LADIES: To be shown at a walk, jog-trot and lope. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability of horse to rider, substance, quality, conformation and attitude.

### **Ranch Horse Division**

The purpose of Ranch Horse Riding should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working ranch horse. The horse's performance should simulate a horse working outside the confines of an arena and that of a working ranch horse. This class should show the horse's ability to work at a forward, working speed while under control of the rider. Light contact should be rewarded and the horse shall not be shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the horse while performing the maneuver requirements and the horse's quality of movement are the primary considerations. The required maneuvers will include the walk, jog and lope both directions; and the extended jog and extended lope going at least one direction; as well as stops and a back.

### **Reining Horse:**

OPEN/AOTR: Exhibitors to perform a pattern from Article B32

### **Trail Horse**

Please refer to the Equestrian Canada Rule Book for further information regarding rules and scoring procedures Article B3401 etc.

### **Equitation Division**

To be shown at a walk, normal trot, sitting trot and canter both ways of the ring. All equitation classes are open to purebred, half and anglo Arabians and are governed by the EC Equitation Division, Section G. Sitting Trot is mandatory in Equestrian Canada rail work, to be performed both directions of the ring. TESTS approved for Hunter Seat Equitation: a) Dismount and mount b) Rein back c) Individual performance d) Figure eight at trot, demonstrating change of diagonals e) Figures eight at canter with simple change of leads through the walk or trot f) Gallop and stop g) Extended trot h) Turn on the haunches through the walk i) Trot and canter without stirrups j) Change leads on a straight line down centre with simple change through the walk or trot k) Counter canter. Tests A – H (13 & Under), Tests A – K (14 – 18).

\*\* The Hand Gallop may only be called for as a test, not on the rail

\*\* In the United States a lengthened stride will be called for as a test, not a hand gallop

Competitors in this division must wear approved protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.

### **Western Horsemanship**

To be judged 50% on the horse's performance and 50% on the rider. Emphasis will be placed on the horse & rider working together on both rail and pattern work. Execution and correct form of both horse and rider, while still maintaining a pleasurable ride are the main criteria for this class. There must be no spins, rollbacks, sliding stops or flying changes in this class.

### **Showmanship**

Open to juniors who have not reached their 19th birthday prior to December 1st of the previous year. Halter showmanship classes demonstrate the ability to fit, prepare and show a horse for halter. Exhibitors may show English, Hunt or Western attire. Exhibitors shall follow the instructions of the judge and ringmaster. To be judged 60% on the handler's showmanship and 40% on presentation.

### **Walk/Trot Division**

Open to purebred, half and anglo arabians. Riders must be 10 or under. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation – EC B39. Riders must not have ever been judged in a class at a recognized show that required a canter or lope.(AHAArticle1013)(ECB39(2))

## Lead Line Division

Open to Purebred, Half and Anglo Arabians. Riders not to cross enter in any other class.

- Leaders must be at least fourteen (14) years of age
- The safety of all exhibitors must be of a primary consideration when conducting these classes. Any action by any exhibitor, leader or horse that endangers that exhibitor or any other exhibitor or leader must be penalized and will be considered a cause for elimination.
- Safety is of utmost importance in tack and attire:
- Saddle must fit rider • Stirrups/irons required. Rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons
- Saddles may be equipped with hooded stirrups or breakaway irons
- Leading rein must be attached to a cavesson or a halter placed under or over top of the bridle
- Safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider, regardless of style of tack and/or attire
- Boots, long pants and long sleeved shirts are required (Res. 34-99)
- There shall only be one rider on each horse entered
- Stallions are prohibited

## TBA Classes

All TBA Classes must be sponsored to run. A class will require a sponsorship of \$20.00. Sponsorships are in addition to the class entry fee.

## Academy Classes

The AHA Academy Riding division is designed to welcome new riders into the Arabian horse show world by offering a positive, low-pressure introduction to competition. Open to beginning riders of any breed, Academy classes provide an opportunity to build skills, gain confidence, and experience the joy of showing within a supportive and educational environment. Sections may be provided to allow multiple riders to show the same horse. **\*Sections will be assigned at instructors request.**

**RIDERS:** \* Are encouraged to be in a professionally operated lesson program. (not required) \* Are encouraged but not required to be an AHA member. First Year Academy Exhibitors are eligible for a FREE AHA Youth Membership. \* Riding saddle seat suits, hunt coats and western chaps are NOT allowed \* Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or colored jeans are considered appropriate. \* A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. \* A riding helmet is MANDATORY for riders 18 years of age and under and suggested for all ages. \* Appropriate footwear with a small heel is MANDATORY. \* Riders are NOT allowed to cross enter into any non-Academy riding classes and are ineligible to compete in Academy classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a non-Academy type show.

**HORSES & EQUIPMENT:** \* Horses must be regularly used as lesson horses: While it is preferred that horses are owned by instructors, horses may be owned or leased by riders IF they are used and shown regularly by other riders as a lesson/school horse. \* Any breed of horse is allowed, and registration is not required. Horses must be suitable to Academy division displaying good manners and a quiet disposition. \* Any horse and rider that is deemed unsafe or is not abiding by these rules may be eliminated by the horse show management or judge. \* A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. \* Work bridles and bits, including snaffles are allowed, and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, the tie down martingales is NOT allowed. \* Horses can cross enter in any Academy type class within the same show, but riders may not cross enter between the Leadline, Walk/Trot, or the Walk/Trot/Canter classes. \* Show grooming is permitted, but not necessary as HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.

**JUDGING:** \* All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage. and upon the riding skills of the rider. \* Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horses rate in a consistent manner. \* Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. \* Headers are allowed in the line up in all walk/trot classes. \* HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses while presenting themselves to their advantage. \* Horsemanship Pleasure is meant to differ from the Equitation class in that it is judged more on the rider's ability to display their horse to its best advantage, communicating to the judge through their horsemanship and riding abilities that the horse is a pleasure to ride and can be guided and set up to show to its best advantage. \* Classes may be split at the discretion of show management. \* Entries into these classes must follow written Show Premium rules but are NOT AHA or USEF sanctioned classes.

AAHABC RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. NO SMOKING in the barns.
2. All entry and stabling fees, copy of registration papers, amateur cards and numbers, AHA cards and numbers, HCBC cards and numbers MUST accompany entry forms for all owners, riders and handlers. A \$10.00 fee will be charged on incomplete entries!
3. Horse Show Office and Stabling Chart will be located at the south end of the Indoor Show Arena. Exhibitors putting horses in stalls not assigned to them will have all entries forfeited. NO changing or removing of stall name cards! A stabling chart will be posted in the both barns and Portables (if applicable), as well as at the show office. Sawdust will be provided.
4. Exhibitors must park their cars, trucks and horse trailers only in the designated areas. NO VEHICLES IN THE HOLDING AREA AND BARN ACCESS WAYS DURING SHOW HOURS!!!
5. All classes to be judged under current EC rules, unless otherwise stated. Rules not covered by the Arabian division of the Rule Book will be covered under their respective EC class division.
6. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules, the same shall be referred to the Steward and Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
7. N/A Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book (A602.2).
8. All entry forms must be completed and signed. NO entry form will be accepted UNLESS SIGNED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF JUNIOR EXHIBITORS WHERE INDICATED. Juniors must give name, age and date of birth on entry form.
9. There will be no refund of entry fees if horses are withdrawn after official date of closing, unless a Veterinarian's Certificate is presented to the Entry Secretary up to and including the final day of the show. Doctor's Certificate's will be honored for Equitation riders only, but must be presented before the conclusion of the show. All queries must be directed to the Show Committee. \$ 10.00 or 10%, whichever is greater, will be withheld from all cancelled entries. NO REFUND OF STABLING!
10. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel classes with insufficient entries: Halter classes - less than four (4); Performance classes - less than six (6); or to combine it with another class, or to divide a class if necessary. In the event that a class is cancelled due to lack of entries, the whole entry fee will be returned and exhibitors notified accordingly.
11. The Show Committee reserves the right to change the order of a class, if necessary. Contestants would be notified, by public announcement, at least 1 class session prior to the change. Classes cannot be held earlier than scheduled unless all entries in that class sign off.

12. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to keep informed with possible class/schedule changes and delays. All changes will be announced. It is up to each individual to be ready and on time for his/her classes!
13. All horses entered must be registered with either the Canadian Partbred Registry, AHA or CAHR. (Arabians with AHA or CAHR; Half & Anglo Arabians with AHA or Canadian Partbred Registry). Registration numbers must appear on the entry forms and contestants MUST show proof of registration and ownership prior to receiving their numbers. No entry numbers will be given out unless copies of these are produced at the show office. (A602.1).
14. All horses must be serviceably sound. In the case of suspected unsoundness, the Judge may have the animal examined by the Show Veterinarian and the decision of the Show Veterinarian shall be final. If the Veterinarian is not on hand, the decision of the judge shall be final. In case the veterinarian finds the horse in question unsound, the bill shall be the responsibility of the horse owner. In case the horse in question is deemed fit to show, the bill shall be the responsibility of AAHABC.
15. The use of chains, rollers or similar devices on the show grounds during or before a show is prohibited and the Show Committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the entire show. Shoeing regulations are as per EC Rule Book.
16. All horses and riders must be appropriately attired or will not be permitted to enter the ring.
17. Each exhibitor is responsible for arriving in the holding area promptly after the class is called by the Whipper-In. A class will be called no more than three (3) times and anyone arriving for a class once the gates are closed will not be permitted to enter the ring, nor will they have their entry fee refunded. Upon entrance of the first horse, a 'two minute' gate will be adhered to.
18. There shall be no conferring with the Judge prior to or during the show. If anyone desires to meet the Judge, this can be arranged through the Show Steward. A protest must be in writing and must be addressed to the Secretary of the Show, and be accompanied by a \$ 110.00 deposit in cash or a certified cheque. It must be filed within forty-eight (48) hours of occurrence of the alleged violation in the class concerned. All protests will be handled according to the EC Rule Book.
19. N/A Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location (A602.5).
20. Horses shall not be punished unnecessarily anywhere on the show grounds. Rules regarding cruelty and abuse covered by the EC will be strictly enforced.
21. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Officials on the part of any owner, groom, rider, handler, driver, etc., the owner may forfeit his/her entry and such action will be reported to (the EC and) AHA. The management reserves to itself the right to remove any handler or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
22. All dogs must be kept on a leash while on the show grounds. Please pick up after your dog.
23. Bicycles, motorcycles, scooters, golf carts, etc. are allowed on the show grounds but prohibited from operating near or in the showring, warm-up rings, stabling areas. Minors who do not have a valid drivers license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle are not permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind on the show grounds. The parent(s), legal guardian(s) or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent/guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.
24. No riding of horses into the stabling areas
25. All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming in the show area will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made, or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judge in performance of his/her duties, he/she shall be excused from competing or exhibiting.
26. All American exhibitors are advised to check into Border regulations well in advance. Please do not write cheques payable in Canadian funds as we are heavily penalized by the banks with service charges. US cheques in US funds or Canadian money or-

ders are acceptable and appreciated.

27. All horses entered in any AHA approved show shall be owned, handled, ridden or driven by a member of AHA or the horse owner, rider, driver or handler shall pay an additional SINGLE EVENT FEE of US\$40.00 (or C\$55.00) per horse that he/she rides, drives, handles or owns to each AHA show. Juniors are no longer exempt.
28. The Veterinarian will be on call and at the expense of the exhibitor calling him. Payment must be made at the time of service for medical attention rendered and is to be paid by the owner or the agent of the horse. VET PERMIT: No Veterinarian other than the official Show Veterinarian will be permitted to treat, medicate, or attend to a horse on the grounds without the expressed written permission of the show management/official veterinarian. Exhibitors wishing to use another veterinarian must designate the farm or training stable the veterinarian will be working for, and obtain a permit for that veterinarian at the show office. Any veterinarian on the show grounds to treat horses must register with the official Show Veterinarian and must record, in writing, with the official show veterinarian, the name of the horse(s), owner, trainer and treatment of said horse(s) on the official form available at the show office or the official show veterinarian. The examination and treatment record used by the examining veterinarian can be substituted for the official form. Any veterinarian treating horses who fails to comply with this required course of action will be expelled from the show grounds. Show veterinarian: Wise Equine Veterinary Services: (604) 888-0087
29. All exhibitors shall be under the direction and control of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor. The AAHABC, the BC Classic Show, the Hot 2 Trot Show, the Fall Frolic Show, Club functions or any other of the sponsors of any of the shows will not be held responsible for injury, loss or theft. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for loss, injury, damage done to; occasioned by; or arising from; any animal exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the AAHABC, The BC Classic Show, the Hot 2 Trot show, the Fall Frolic Show, Club functions, the Thunderbird Show Park and Show Sponsors against legal or other proceedings in regard hereto.
30. Junior exhibitors are not eligible to ride in Adult Amateur Owner (AAOTR) or Adult Amateur (AATR) classes. Where entries warrant, the Show Committee reserves the right to split Amateur Owner To Ride (AOTR) classes into Junior Owner To Ride (JOTR) and Adult Amateur Owner To Ride (AAOTR). AAOTR classes may be split into 19 - 39 and 40 & Over.
31. WHIP ABUSE: Judges will be required to excuse from the ring any horse shown at halter or performance that possesses a whip mark (welt) on any portion of its body. Rule 3-12: Any person reported to the Show Management as abusing a horse with a whip or other such devices, whether it be in the stable area, trailer area, hitching ring, warm up ring or show ring; and causing a disturbance as to affect the conduct and safety of other horses, and/or exhibitors, and/or spectators, shall be liable to disciplinary action. Such action may vary from a warning to expulsion from the ring, to suspension of a number of shows, to report to EPRB. NO ABUSE of horses shall be tolerated! In the event that this division fails to have a rule to cover a situation or where the rule is contradictory or ambiguous, then the Steward/Judge/Show Officials shall refer to the current AHA handbook for guidance.
32. Lungeing is allowed in the designated lungeing areas only! No exceptions!
33. All adult entrants riding in AOTR/ATR classes MUST have 'Amateur Status' indicated on their current EC card to participate in any Amateur divisions. When applying for your EC membership, be sure to fill out the Amateur Application section.
34. All horses ridden at Thunderbird Show Park during the AAHABC rental period must be appropriately saddled, bridled and ridden in a safe manner. Riders must wear appropriate footwear when riding. Riders not following this rule may forfeit entries.
35. Riders must dismount prior to entering stabling areas.
36. Gateholds must be asked for and approved at least 3 classes prior. Gate holds are approved by the whipper in and show manager. Gate holds will only be granted for tack, rider or horse changes. Gateholds, if granted are 3 minutes only. That, added to the 2 minute open gate, provides a total of 5 minutes.
37. Horses that are NOT competing in the show may not be brought on to the show grounds without permission of Show Management.

## ATTENTION AMERICAN EXHIBITORS

It is easy to cross the border. Take Exit 275 off I-5, for the Pacific Crossing. You can also use Sumas and Aldergrove. Pacific and Sumas are open 24/7. Aldergrove is open from 8:00 am – midnight.

To cross the border into Canada, you are required to have a United States origin Health Certificate, V.S. Form 17-40. The date it is issued must not be more than thirty (30) days prior to export. The certificate must have a USDA seal in the bottom left hand corner.

You must also have a valid Coggins test, which is good for up to one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date it is issued.

Prior to stopping at the Canadian Customs crossing, check with the American Customs office. It is suggested, not required, that at that time you leave them a list of tack and equipment in your trailer, which will make your return through the border somewhat faster. Proceed to the Canadian Customs office and have your papers checked. Returning home, go straight through to the American Customs office. It is NOT necessary to have a Veterinarian inspection if you are in Canada less than thirty (30) days. However, if you plan to be over thirty (30) days from the date the horses were checked at your farm, not crossing the border, you must have the above documents and meet the Veterinarian at the border for inspection between the hours of 8:00- 10:00 AM, or 3:00-4:00 PM, Monday to Friday. The telephone number of the Veterinarian office in Blaine, WA is (206)332-8853. The phone number of the Canadian Veterinarian at the border is (604)538-3655, or the office at (604)538-3544.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE(S) AND MY PROPERTY. I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites, or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals. I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the Released Parties) from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorney's fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorney's fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition, and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, Equestrian Canada or U.S. Equestrian Federation permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers, or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition. I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain in effect.
